Hampshire County Council Report
Cllr Jan Warwick June 2019

1. The HCC County Councillor Grant fund opened on 1st June for applications up to £1000 from each parish across the Downlands Division. Further details are available on www.hants.gov.uk (search County Councillor Grants)
2. Please do take part in County Council's consultation: Balancing the Budget for 2020-2021. The online response form is at www.hants.gov.uk/balancingthebudget Paper copies can be requested by emailing insight@hants.gov.uk or calling 0300 555 1375 and will also be available from local Hampshire libraries.
3. HCC has adopted an electric vehicle-charging framework for the public sector estate (eg schools and libraries) to help facilitate new charging points across the county. The county council is also exploring options for those properties without off road parking that require kerbside vehicle charging.
