Public using facilities	Contraction of Covid-19 via persons or Contact with objects	Members of the public	Severity - 4 Likelihood- 2 Risk Level - 8	Social distancing signs have been installed. Additional signage to remind of the need to wash hands, use hand sanitiser and wait if the area is busy have been installed. Signage will be regularly inspected and replaced if required. A community volunteering scheme will be considered to carry out low level sanitisations and signage inspections daily. Hand sanitiser will not be installed due to the risk of theft and vandalism. Social distancing measures within the playgrounds will be considered if there are high numbers of users. e.g. removing every other swing and marking out queueing lines. Food and drink is banned from the playgrounds. Public asked to take their litter home.	Severity – 4 Likelihood– 1 Risk Level - 4
Public using facilities	Injury or illness from cleaning products	Members of the public	Severity - 3 Likelihood– 2 Risk Level- 6	Low risk product could be used. Spraying will be done in closed areas. The public will be reminded not to lick or put their mouths on the equipment.	Severity – 2 Likelihood– 1 Risk Level - 2
Social distancing	Members of the public and staff not adhering to social distancing measures.	Staff and public	Severity – 3 Likelihood– 3 Risk Level– 9	Signage in place Queue system will be put in place if numbers of users are high. Social distancing measures within the assets have been installed.	Severity – 3 Likelihood– 2 Risk level - 6
