Photo Competition 2021

Terms & Conditions

1. The theme for the competition is "Life in Badger Farm". We are looking for photographs that show off the visual delights of the area and the life of its residents. Photos must be taken within Badger Farm.
2. The competition is open to all residents of Badger Farm
3. Each entrant may enter up to three photographs. Photos must feature Badger Farm locations.
4. The closing date for entries is 31 March 2022. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
5. Winners will be announced at the Parish Council Annual Meeting on 9 May 2021
6. By entering the competition entrants will be deemed to be bound by these rules.
7. Entries should be submitted in the highest resolution possible via email to clerk@badgerfarm-pc.gov.uk Please include your name, address and a contact email address or telephone number and details of when and where each image was taken.
8. Entrants under 18 will need the permission of their parent or guardian and their details will need to be provided with the entry. All communications will be made through the parent/guardian.
9. Photographs must be the original work of the entrant and entrants confirm that they do not infringe the rights of any other individual or organisation. By entering their photographs entrants confirm that they are the sole owners of copyright in the images they submit and must have obtained the permission of any people featured in the images (or their parents/guardians if those people are under 16)
10. Entrants will retain the copyright in the photographs. By entering the competition grant Badger Farm Parish Council the right to use the images on their website or in other Parish Council publications in perpetuity.
11. Members of Badger Farm Parish Council and their families may enter the competition however, they will not be eligible for prizes.



12. Editing: Cropping images and basic colour enhancement is fine but no composite images (i.e. photos made from more than one image or digital special effects) will be eligible for prizes.

13. When taking photos of flora or fauna entrants must not cause injury to or do anything to cause distress to any animal or damage to its habitat while taking a photograph. This includes the flying of drones which should not be flown too close to wildlife or their habitats or nests.

14. When taking photographs entrants must observe all current Government guidance regarding Covid-19

15. The prizes will be as follows:
 - a. 1st Place - £100
 - b. 2nd Place – £50
 - c. 3rd Place - £25
 - d. Junior winner (under 16 years) – £25

16. Photos will be shortlisted by the members of Badger Farm Parish Council and the winners will be chosen by an independent judge.

17. Photos will be judged according to:
 - Composition
 - Technical ability
 - Originality
 - Relevance to the theme of "Life in Badger Farm"
 - Suitability for inclusion on the Badger Farm Parish Council Website
